ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

1. A letter about yourself, why you are applying for this scholarship and why you want a college degree.
2. Two character references from **teachers, professors or employers**.
3. An up-to-date copy of your transcript from WU, the college from which you are transferring or high school if you haven't started college.
4. A recent photograph appropriate for potential publication.

ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS

1. Awards will be determined by the information on this application only. Personal interviews will not be held as they have in the past.
2. Applications must be received by the Washburn University Foundation, 1729 S.W. MacVicar, Topeka, Kansas 66604, **no later than February 25, 2014**.

3. Scholarship funds may be used for fall and spring semesters. Summer awards will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
