Terms and Conditions

Deposit and Full Payment - A deposit of \$150 per person is required to confirm a reservation. Final payment will be due Travel Leaders on or before Friday, November 3, 2017. All deposits and final payments may be made by either cash, check or credit card. There are no additional service fees for credit card charges.

Cancellation - For any cancellations made prior to Friday, **September 15, 2017**, there will be a \$50 per person cancellation fee. For cancellations after Friday, **September 15 through Friday, November 10, 2017**, there will be a \$150 per person cancellation fee; for cancellations after **November 3, 2017** up to and including departure including no-shows, and cancellation while on tour, there is a 100% cancellation penalty. Name changes provided to Travel Leaders in writing will be considered but subject to the provisions of hotel/supplier contracts. Name changes requested after documents are printed will be assessed a \$75 per person name change fee plus any charges, if any, to effect the name change.

Documentation IMPORTANT - Since March 1, 2010, all U.S. citizens – including minors – are required to present a valid passport when traveling to Mexico. Passport cards may NOT be used. U.S. passports must have at least 6 months minimum validity remaining upon return to the U.S. with an expiration date on or after July 28, 2017. A Mexican tourist card will be required for entrance into Mexico which will be provided by Frontier Airlines prior to arrival in Cancun.

Travel Insurance - Travel Leaders encourages the use of travel insurance for this program. In the unlikely event of accidents and illness, travel insurance insures peace of mind against the unforeseen. Unfortunately things do sometimes happen and travel insurance can be a big help, both emotionally and financially. We can forward travel insurance information to you once you have approved this program or include the forms upon receipt of passenger deposits.

Not Included – Items purely of a personal nature such as gifts and souvenirs, telephone calls, laundry, tours and excursions, and other activities not specified as included in the tour price, customary gratuities to the driver, local guides, interpreters, and assistants, trip cancellation, checked luggage fees and insurance.
